Evidence & assessment notes

Assessment inside Questipedia

Every quest ends with an auto-marked outcome that lands in the teacher dashboard: percentage correct, time taken, and the specific sub-objectives the pupil got wrong. Teachers can export a class report as CSV.

Progression model

Pupils are placed on an adaptive path based on cold-start diagnostics. The path adjusts nightly using the pupil's rolling accuracy across each strand.

Inclusion & accessibility

Dyslexia-friendly font toggle, text-to-speech on all question prompts, adjustable timers, and no penalty for slower response speeds.
