## Sample questions with model answers

### Verbal reasoning

**Q1.** Which word is closest in meaning to 'jubilant'? (sombre, ecstatic, tired, cautious) [1 mark]

*Answer: ecstatic*

**Q2.** Complete the analogy: PAINTER is to BRUSH as SCULPTOR is to \_\_\_\_ [1 mark]

*Answer: chisel*

### Non-verbal reasoning

**Q3.** A square is rotated 90° clockwise. Which corner is now top-right? (top-left / top-right / bottom-left / bottom-right, originally labelled A B C D) [1 mark]

*Answer: The corner originally at top-left (A).*

### Maths problem solving

**Q4.** A tap fills a tank in 12 minutes. Another fills it in 6 minutes. Together, how long? [2 marks]

*Answer: 4 minutes*

### Comprehension

**Q5.** From the extract, why does the character hesitate before opening the door? (extract in full bank) [2 marks]

*Answer: She fears her father may already be waiting inside with bad news.*
